HIRING THE WRONG PI CAN COST YOU THE CASE

Anyone can call themselves an "investigator." But in Florida, only a **licensed agency** can legally gather evidence that a court will accept — and the difference decides whether your time and money mean anything. Before you pay a cent, use this guide.

THE CHECKLIST

7 QUESTIONS TO ASK ANY INVESTIGATOR

1 Are you a licensed Florida agency?

Ask for the agency license number (ours is A1800135). Unlicensed "PIs" can get your evidence thrown out.

2 Are you insured?

A real agency carries liability insurance. If they hesitate, walk away.

3 Will your evidence be court-admissible?

Surveillance has to be gathered legally and documented properly, or a judge won't allow it.

4 What are your rates — all in?

Ask about hourly rates, mileage, and reporting so there are no surprise invoices.

5 How do you protect my confidentiality?

Your case should never be discussed with anyone but you. Ever.

6 Have you handled cases like mine?

Infidelity, custody, background, and locate cases each need different tactics.

7 What will I actually receive?

Expect a written report, time-stamped photos/video, and a clear summary of findings.

WHAT A LICENSED PI CAN & CAN'T DO

✓ A licensed PI CAN

- ✓ Conduct surveillance from public spaces
- ✓ Run background & asset checks
- ✓ Locate people and verify addresses
- ✓ Document infidelity for court or divorce
- ✓ Gather court-admissible photo & video

✗ No one legally CAN'T

- ✗ Wiretap or record private calls illegally
- ✗ Hack phones, email, or social accounts
- ✗ Trespass onto private property
- ✗ Pull protected bank or medical records
- ✗ Place a GPS tracker they're not allowed to

Why it matters: evidence gathered illegally isn't just useless — it can get *your* case dismissed and expose you to liability. A real agency knows exactly where the line is.
